Maths

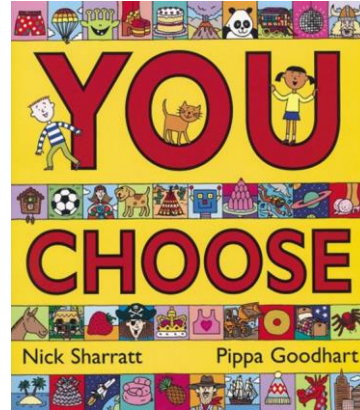
