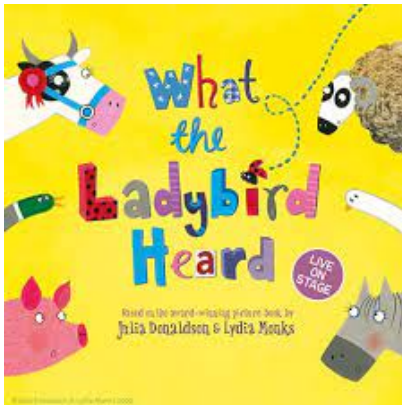
Spring Half-term Newsletter

We have had a lovely two weeks settling back into the school routines, after the christmas holidays. The children are all very calm and settled and are so excited about their learning!

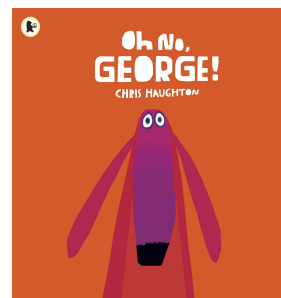
Project

We have started the term off by reading the book 'What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson and Lydia Monks.



The children will be exploring animals on a farm, including: the noises they make, what they eat, what they look like and about their young. The children will also be coming up with their own ladybird journey around a farm and using the animal sounds to help retell it.

After this we will be moving on to read "Oh No George" by Chris Houghton. This story is about a dog who has to make some tricky choices! It is very funny! The children will be helping George make good choices and supporting him with making amends when he has done wrong. We will also be inviting a dog in to meet us and talking to the owner about how to look after it.



Maths- In Maths we are going over numbers to 5 through singing and chanting. Your child should be confident with singing '5 little ducks', '5 little men in a flying saucer' and '5 little monkeys jumping on a bed'. These songs take the children backwards from 5 down to 0. The children will learn positional language and build their ability to follow and give directions and use language accurately.
