Throughout the term we will be having PSHE lessons under the topic of "Changing Me" along with the rest of the school. We will be thinking about how the children have changed and grown since being a baby. We would be grateful if you could

send in photos of the children as babies and toddlers to compare. These can either be printed or posted on Google Classroom. We will also be learning about lifecycles and the human body parts as part of this unit. Please speak to your class teacher if you have any questions about the Year 1 content.


PE and Performing Arts Kit

This term our PE day is **Wednesday**. Children are to come to school in their PE kits- plain white top and black bottoms.

Children have Performing Arts lessons on **Thursday** and they are expected to come to school wearing their dance and drama kits - black tops and black bottoms. This counts as our second weekly PE lesson.

English and Geography

This term our project focus is geography. Year 1 will be asking the question: **Where does litter go?** We will take a look at litter in our local community and think about how littering impacts the world on a wider scale, in particular how plastic travels through our oceans.
